



# HOW TO MAKE A BIRD FEEDER

## Materials:

- Tissue Paper Roll
- Hole Punch
- Yarn or twine
- Birdseed
- Peanut Butter, Lard, or Honey
- Plastic or Butter Knife
- Paper Plate

## Instructions:

1. Use a hole punch to punch holes into either side of one end of the craft roll.
2. Pour a little birdseed onto a craft plate so it covers the bottom of the plate.
3. Use a butter knife to spread on peanut butter (or lard or honey).
4. Roll the coated craft roll in the birdseed so the birdseed sticks to the roll.
5. Take 8-12 inches of yarn or twine and feed it through both ends of the punched holes. Then tie the ends together.
6. Hang the bird feeder in your backyard!

## Did You Know:
